Cutting Options:







Score face side of the panel a few times with a utility knife and snap the tile at the line.

Use a circular saw or table saw with a fine-tooth blade to provide a smooth cut.

Tools and Materials:

- Protective eye wear
- Measuring tape
- Level
- Utility knife
- Hand saw or circular/table saw
- Drill bit & jig saw (for cutting holes)

- Silicone-based sealant for kitchen/bath (for wet environments)
- Panel adhesive rated for PVC
- · Optional: matching trim
- Optional: shims
- Optional: painter's tape

Basic Installation:







Installation is quick and grout-less using tube adhesive



Apply panels directly onto wall.

Clean all installation surfaces. Ensure they are dry and free of any dirt, dust or debris prior to installing any wall panels.


Before applying adhesive, dry fit the panels to ensure they fit correctly. Cut any panels as needed to achieve a proper fit. Apply an even distribution of adhesive to the back of the panel. Using even pressure, press the first panel firmly into place with your hands, making sure the panel is level and flush with the surrounding surfaces. Wipe off excess adhesive.

Continue to install the remaining panels in this manner. If wall panel edges are interlocking, fully insert the panel tongue into the groove of the adjoining panel.


Use a silicone-based sealant to seal the edges of the panels where they meet the bathtub, floor, and ceiling. Allow the adhesive to dry before using the shower or bathtub.

60" Rear x 36" Sides




60" Rear x 30" Sides



48" Rear x 36" Sides




48" Rear x 36" Sides
